At Enerquip, making a positive impact in our communities is more than a goal—it's part of who we are. We believe in putting others first and improving the quality of life where we work, play, and live.

In addition to our corporate donations and sponsorships, our employees actively serve on boards and volunteer with local nonprofits. We also support their efforts through our Employee Match Program, which matches gifts 100%, up to \$500 per employee each calendar year.

Our Focus Areas

We prioritize support for causes in the following areas:

1. **Education** – Local schools, academic programs, and educational activities
2. **Human Needs** – Health, wellness, and basic needs services
3. **Civic & Community** – Projects that enhance community life, safety, and infrastructure

Enerquip does not fund:

- For-profit businesses
- Politically affiliated organizations

Requesting Donations: Up to \$10,000

- Submit a community giving request **at least 35 days before funds are needed**
- Applications are reviewed monthly
- Limit one request per organization per calendar year
- We do not fund retroactive requests (i.e., for past events or already-purchased items)

Requesting Donations: Over \$10,000

- Submit a community giving request **at least 90 days before funds are needed**
- Applications are reviewed monthly
- Limit one request per organization per calendar year
- We do not fund retroactive requests (i.e., for past events or already-purchased items)

Enerquip reserves large-scale donations for well-planned projects with broad community impact. If your request falls into this category, below are the guidelines and what we'll need to consider the donation.

Our Support is a Pledge, Not a Payment

Large donations are made as *pledges*, not lump-sum payments. This means we commit to giving a total amount distributed in phases as your project reaches key milestones.

Donation Agreement Required

If approved, a formal agreement must be signed outlining:

- The total pledged amount
- Payment schedule tied to project milestones
- Documentation and reporting requirements
- Recognition or naming rights (if applicable)
- Conditions for pausing or canceling future payments

What to Include in Your Proposal

To help us [evaluate your request](#), please include:

- A full project timeline and phases
- A detailed, itemized budget
- Key individuals or contractors involved
- Who will own and maintain the project when complete
- Status of other funding sources
- A plan in case the project stalls or fails
- Any public matching or community fundraising components

Reporting & Progress Updates

We may ask for:

- Regular financial updates (quarterly or at milestones)
- Progress reports with photos and/or site visit opportunities
- A final report and full accounting upon completion

Payment Installments

A typical disbursement schedule might look like:

- 10% – Upon confirmation of full project funding
- 40% – At project kickoff
- 25% – At the halfway point
- 25% – Upon completion

Before releasing funds, we may:

- Request the right to audit or review how funds are used
- Require permits and insurance to be in place
- Ask for a plan to address cost overruns
- Require funds to be held in escrow
- Restrict donations to specific project components (e.g., equipment, materials—not overhead or unrelated expenses)
